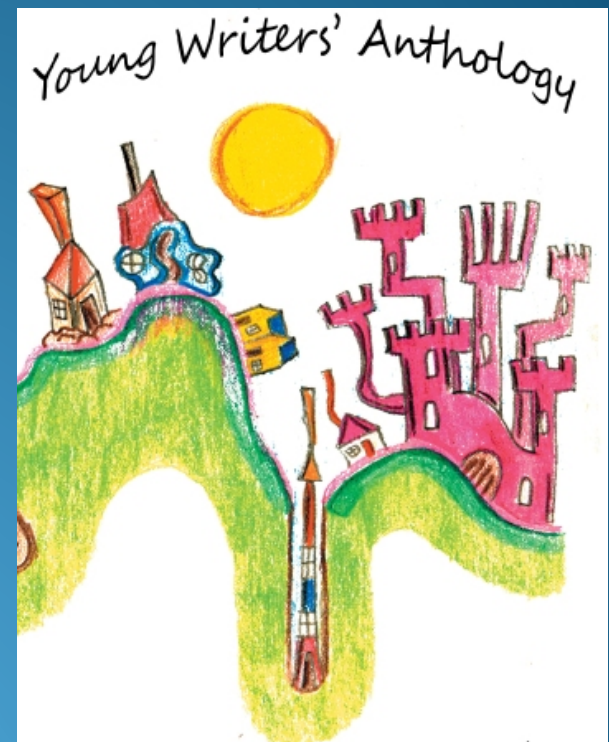

Good News

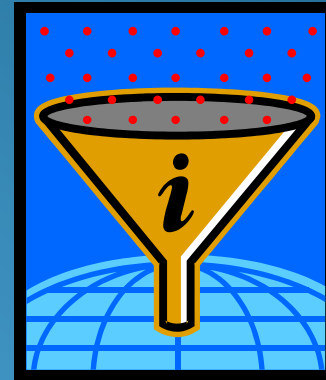
1. Presentation “Number Sense: It’s as Easy as 1,2,3” has been accepted by the National Title I Conference Board.
